



Industry-Based Credentials (IBCs)

All students enrolled in a degree, diploma, or certificate program at Nunez Community College who meet the requirements established in the Nunez “Awarding Credit for Prior Learning” policy shall be eligible for and receive college credit (grade of P) via Industry-Based Credential. The College considers the training and assessment required to obtain certain IBCs as being equivalent to certain courses that students may take for credit. Students who are currently enrolled and have previously successfully completed industry-based certifications (IBCs) may be eligible for credit in the following courses:
