

AAUW Covington-Mandeville

The American Association of University Women (AAUW) Covington-Mandeville branch would like to present a \$1500 scholarship for books or supplies to a young woman who has a great desire to increase her education. Our focus is on the student who does not qualify for an academic scholarship; students who receive an academic scholarship are not eligible. **The student must reside in St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, or Washington Parish** and plan to attend Delgado Community College, Northshore Technical Community College, Baton Rouge Community College or Nunez Community College.

If currently enrolled, a copy of a current transcript is required. If not currently enrolled, a copy of High School diploma or GED certificate/HiSET is required. The applicant must be pursuing her first associate or higher degree. The awardee will be announced June 30th. Proof of attendance is required before the funds will be released. Please block out your Social Security number on all documents. All submissions will be destroyed after one year.

The student must fill out the application and supply the required materials by May 24, 2019.

- 1. Provide three letters (limit 200 words) stating why you should be awarded this scholarship.
 - a. One letter written by the applicant
 - b. One letter written by a relative or guardian (please identify the relationship)
 - c. The third letter written by a teacher, counselor or other school authority
- 2. The applicant must submit a resume including anything that would describe her accomplishments and future goals (maximum of 5 pages).
- 3. Proof of enrollment or graduation as stated above.
- 4. The applicant may be called for an interview.

The awardee should be willing to be a spokesperson for this program at AAUW events.
