



NURSING ASSISTANT CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

Nunez Community College offers a seven week Nursing Assistant Certificate Program. This program is approved by the State of Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals and is in compliance with State/Federal regulations.

This program prepares students for employment in long-term care facilities, home health agencies, and hospitals where basic bedside nursing care is needed. Classroom instruction includes an introduction to health care, basic nursing skills, body structure and function, and infection control. Students will also participate in clinical activities under the close supervision of instructors. In addition to nursing related courses, the program provides instruction in the job seeking process.

Upon successful completion of the program, the student is qualified to apply for certification through the Louisiana Certified Nurse Aide Registry.
