Key Factors:

- Planning for Fall 2010 & Spring 2011 Dual Enrollment is contingent upon the Board of Regents continuing its allocation of Early Start funds for the 2010-2011 school year.
- All participants must either be Early Start-eligible, or attach a tuition check to the application.
- All *completed* applications (with necessary attachments) are due to Nunez Community College by August 20, 2010 (Fall 2010), or January 12, 2011 (Spring 2011).
- All high schools should identify the courses they desire to offer their students for fall 2010 before the end of the 2009-10 school year, or before the Christmas holidays for Spring to ensure that proper planning of instructors and textbooks is carried out (email addresses of high school teachers next to the course would be helpful).
- If funding is available, a Dual Enrollment Workshop, to include stipends will be offered at Nunez in the summer 2010.
- If a Nunez instructor is sent to the high school campus, a minimum of 15 students is required.
